There, she supported multi-stakeholder partnerships in 12 countries across Southeast Asia, Africa, and South America to mobilize investment and coordination amongst global food companies (Cargill, Mondelez, Nestle, SABMiller, Syngenta, Unilever, Yara amongst others), heads of state (including the G7), UN agencies (EDP, FAO, WFP) and farmer organizations.

Eva also serves as **Board President** for the <u>Upcycled Food Foundation</u>. In this position, Eva uses her expertise to spearhead initiatives to promote sustainable food practices by championing the transformation of food waste into innovative and nutritious products. With her leadership, she fosters collaborations, drives awareness, and advances the mission of reducing food waste and creating a more sustainable food system.
